LISA-MARIE CALDERONE-STEWART SCHOLARSHIP for the 2013 National Catholic Youth Conference & the 2013 National Catholic Collegiate Conference

The Region VII Youth Ministry Coalition, an organization of diocesan youth ministry leaders and collaborating youth-serving organizations from Illinois, Indiana and Wisconsin, has approved up to \$2,000 in funding for teens and young adults to attend the 2013 National Catholic Youth Conference (NCYC) and the 2013 National Catholic Collegiate Conference, both in Indianapolis.

The scholarships honor the contributions to youth ministry made by the late **Dr. Lisa Marie Calderone-Stewart**. Lisa-Marie is the former director of youth ministry in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, and founder of *Tomorrow's Present*, a program focused on developing youth leadership skills, based out of Cardinal Stritch University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Over the years, Lisa-Marie has written books and developed resources on how to better utilize the gifts and skills of teen leaders to grow youth ministry programs. Accordingly, the **Lisa-Marie Calderone-Stewart NCYC/NCCC scholarships will be awarded to young people who have demonstrated a willingness and desire to fulfill their baptismal call to lead others to Christ.**
